

## 2014 Sports and Entertainment Bee Round 1

1. One movie starring this character sees Eckhardt killed at the Axis Chemical plant; that movie also sees the antagonist use the catchphrase “Ever dance with the devil in the pale moonlight?” In a different movie, this character retrieves a blue flower for the Liam-Neeson played Ducard. Portrayed at different times by Val Kilmer, George Clooney, and Michael Keaton, name this superhero recently played by Christian Bale in a series of Christopher Nolan films.

ANSWER: **Batman** [or **Bruce Wayne**]

2. Kate Winslet plays the primary antagonist in this recent film, set in a future version of Chicago. Said antagonist, Jeanine Matthews, uses serum to mind-control one of the factions, Dauntless, to do her bidding and overthrow the Abnegation faction. Name this 2014 film whose title is a synonym for variant.

ANSWER: **Divergent**

3. Standing 6’6” and weighing 285 pounds, he is known as the Big Donkey and was the 50<sup>th</sup> player to hit 400 career MLB home runs. He is a two-time All-Star and has played for the Chicago White Sox, Cincinnati Reds, Arizona Diamondbacks, and Washington Nationals. Name this left-fielder turned first-baseman turned designated hitter who has struck out over 2,200 times in his career and batted a stunning .159 in 2011, his first year in the Windy City?

ANSWER: Adam **Dunn**

4. This actress played the lead role in *Winter's Bone*, and was Mystique in *X-Men: First Class*. She also received the Best Actress award at the Oscars in 2012 for her role in *Silver Linings Playbook*. She is more known, however for her role in an adaptation of a young adult dystopian novel. Name this actress from *The Hunger Games*?

ANSWER: Jennifer **Lawrence**

5. One song by this band opens “Oh, no, I see/ A spider web, it’s tangled up with me,” and that song appears on an album along with “Everything’s Not Lost” and “Spies.” A different song of theirs closes “Lights will guide you home/ And ignite your bones,” while yet another notes “For some reason I can’t explain/ I know Saint Peter won’t call my name. Fronted by Chris Martin, name this band that created the album X&Y and the song “Viva la Vida.”

ANSWER: **Coldplay**

6. Most of the seats at this ballpark are dark green save for the 20<sup>th</sup> row in the upper deck. A waterfall, and pine trees stand behind the center field wall, and fountains shoot water into the air after the home team hits a home run. This stadium was the first major league park to feature an underground heating system, a wise addition in a city whose average April low is just above freezing. Name this ballpark in which a purple row of seats indicates the city’s one mile elevation point?

ANSWER: **Coors Field**

7. “Y'all are acting like a bunch of sissies! Quit it!” yells Sheryl, played by a young Hayden Panettiere in this film. The camp that players attend in this film was filmed at Berry College in Georgia, a school without a football team and a long way from the Peach Orchard or Little Round Top. Name this 2000 film that portrays Herman Boone and the newly integrated T.C. Williams football team.

ANSWER: **Remember the Titans**

8. George Lazenby played this character only once, and loses the woman he loves at the end of the movie. Created in 1953 by Ian Fleming, this fictional British spy's movie series is one of the highest-grossing of all time. Name this character, first played by Sean Connery and currently played by Daniel Craig?

ANSWER: James **Bond**

9. One song by this band says that “Lend me your hand and we'll conquer them all/ But lend me your heart and I'll just watch you fall.” With Jerry Douglas and Paul Simon, this band covered “The Boxer” on an album that also included the songs “Holland Road” and “Hopeless Wanderer.” Known for the albums Babel and Sigh No More, name this English folk rock band of “Little Lion Man” and “I Will Wait.”

ANSWER: **Mumford and Sons**

10. First performed by Frank Jobe in 1974, this procedure involves the drilling of holes into the ulna and humerus bones and the moving of the ulnar nerve. Joel Zumaya, Jordan Zimmerman, and Steven Strasburg have all undergone this procedure, which allowed its namesake to win 164 games after tearing his UCL. Name the procedure named for the pitcher who finished with 288 career victories, seventh-most all-time for a lefthander.

ANSWER: **Tommy John Surgery**

11. The singer of one song by this band was “Celebrated but undisturbed/ Serenaded by the terror bird and the songs “Blackeyed Blond” and “American Ghost Dance” appear on this band's 1985 album Freaky Styley. The title track of a different album by this band opens “Psychic spies from China/ Try to steal your mind's elation.” Name this rock band of the albums Californication and Stadium Arcadium.

ANSWER: **Red Hot Chili Peppers**

12. The first three movies of this character's franchise had the feel of 1930s adventure serials, while the fourth was more in the vein of a 1950s science fiction movie. The title character eventually marries Marion Ravenwood, and is known for his use of a bullwhip and wearing of a fedora. Name this adventurer archaeologist played by Harrison Ford.

ANSWER: **Indiana Jones**

13. The Double-A affiliate of this team is the Birmingham Barons and this team plays home games at U.S. Cellular Field. This team had one of the earliest major scandals in baseball when several players were accused of purposefully losing games, a scandal known as the “black” version of this team's name. Name this Chicago baseball team.

ANSWER: Chicago **White Sox**

14. He holds the Major League record for strikeout-to-walk ratio for a player with a minimum of 100 innings pitched and captured a bronze medal at the 2004 Olympics. In 2006, he led the World Baseball Classic with 16 strikeouts and didn't make his big league debut until 2009 with the Baltimore Orioles. Name this baseball closer who was traded to Texas for Chris Davis and Tommy Hunter and recorded the final out of the 2013 World Series for the Boston Red Sox.

ANSWER: Koji **Uehara**

15. This sequel is based around an unpublished Frank Miller work and takes place shortly after the movie to which it is a sequel. Supposedly based on the Battle of Salamis during the second Persian Invasion of Greece, this is what 2014 sequel to a movie concerning a certain number of Spartans?

ANSWER: **300: Rise of an Empire**

16. This long-time player for the Detroit Tigers was notorious for supposedly filing his spikes on the bench and then sliding into bases with them held high. Despite playing early in the twentieth century, he is still the player with the second-highest number of runs scored and total hits in Major League Baseball history. Name this Georgian Peach with 4,191 career hits.

ANSWER: Ty **Cobb**

17. One song by this group says to "Look around, the grass is high/The fields are ripe, it's the springtime of my life," while another states that "I saw a shadow touch a shadow's hand" on the title road. Besides "Hazy Shade of Winter" and "Bleecker Street," this group created a song that discusses "People talking without speaking/ People hearing without listening," and another that says "I will lay me down." Name this duo who created "The Sound of Silence" and "Bridge Over Troubled Water."

ANSWER: **Simon & Garfunkel**

18. Despite being passed on the final lap by Joey Logano in the 2014 Duck Commander 500 at Texas Motor Speedway, he ended the race as the Sprint Cup points leader, his first time atop the standings since May, 2009. His first trip to victory lane in NASCAR's top series came in 1994 at Charlotte and the most recent of his 88 wins came last year in Martinsville. Name this man known for his Rainbow Warrior paint scheme, currently married to Ingrid Vandebosch, and driver of the #24 car.

ANSWER: Jeff **Gordon**

19. The ad agency behind this campaign claimed it resulted in a 20% reduction in risky behavior, though [mumbrella.com](http://mumbrella.com) disparaged that as "social media bullshit." Devised by McCann Melbourne, this campaign featured a character who bears a striking resemblance to half a pink grapefruit after antagonizing a bear. In Russia, this campaign was censored with the message of "This content is not available due to a legal complaint from the government" on Youtube. Developed to reduce fatalities in Melbourne, Australia due to behavior around trains, this is which 2012 internet meme video, showing stupid ways of ending one's existence?

ANSWER: **Dumb Ways to Die**

20. Frank Wycheck threw a famous lateral pass to Kevin Tyson resulting in a touchdown against the Buffalo Bills. This team began in 1960 as the Houston Oilers, and they retained the “Oilers” portion for two years after they left that city. After making an initial move in 1997, they shifted again in 1999 and changed their name to their current moniker, and currently play at LP Field. Name this NFL franchise that plays in Nashville.

21. As of April 2014, this artist’s music video for 2010 sporting event is the eighth most-watched video on YouTube. This artist’s best-selling album is 2001’s Laundry Service, which included songs like “Objection” and “Whenever, Wherever”. Her best-known song featured Wyclef Jean, who says “she makes a man wanna speak Spanish”. Name this Colombian singer of “Hips Don’t Lie”, a coach on The Voice.

ANSWER: **Shakira** Isabel Mebarak Ripoll

22. Turning down offers from Florida St., South Florida, Boston College, and Alabama, he chose to attend West Virginia University where he backed up Jarrett Brown as a freshman. In the final game of his college career, he completed 21 consecutive passes to break Chase Daniel’s Big 12 record and finished with 407 yards and only one incomplection. Name this 2012 Orange Bowl MVP who threw 21interceptions for the New York Jets in 2013.

ANSWER: **Geno Smith**

23. The Canton Charge are the Developmental League affiliate of this NBA team which began in 1970 as an expansion team. It has never won a championship but came close in 2010 before losing to the Boston Celtics in the second round of playoffs, a defeat that may have led to a notorious team change by its best player. Name this team that lost LeBron James to the Miami Heat and recently retired the number of Zydrunas Ilgauskas.

ANSWER: Cleveland **Cavaliers**

24. The longest one of these lasted 15 rounds at Madison Square Garden in 2005. In that final round, Olaf Kolzig faced off with 6’5” 235-pound Marek Malik. Washington’s Nicklas Backstrom had the most attempts in one of these in 2013-14 and converted on over 40 percent while teammate Alex Ovechkin went just 2-16 in what, introduced in the 2005-06 season to follow four-on-four overtime in regular season NHL games?

ANSWER: **Shootout**

25. Companies bought by this one include Lexcycle and Zappos, and it acquired Liquavista and GoodReads last year. This company owns Audible.com and IMDb, and in late 2013 it unveiled plans to deliver products via drone. Founded by Jeff Bezos, identify this company that includes the “Prime,” service, the largest online retailer in the world.

ANSWER: **Amazon**

26. The Dragons and Claymores were the first teams to go defunct in this league after a 1998 rebranding. The final champion of this league was the Hamburg Sea Devils in 2007 continuing the run of German dominance in this league. Jon Kitna and Kurt Warner both graduated from this league which also featured the Berlin Thunder and Rhein Fire and served as a developmental league for young players?

**NFL Europe** [or **NFL Europa**]

27. This movie lost the Best Picture category of the Academy Awards to the movie for which John Ford won his third Oscar as best director, *How Green Was My Valley*. This movie is based around the search for the source of a dying newspaper mogul's last word, which concerns his sled. Name this Orson Welles movie based on William Randolph Hearst's life that centers around the word "Rosebud".

In *The Pursuit of Happyness*, Will Smith's character uses one of these products during a taxi ride in an effort to land him a job. Known for approximately 43 quintillion possible combinations, name this multicolored six-sided puzzle device.
