FB: Football- from the first game in 1869 to Super Bowl XLI, this category covers both NFL and college football teams, games and players.

MLB: From the deadball era to the Cubs breaking the curse, this will cover teams, players, and all things baseball

BB: From Naismith's peach baskets to the Final Four, if it's orange and dribbles, it's here.

Other Sports: This category covers sports not found in the "Big Four" such as Soccer, the Olympics, NASCAR, etc.

Movies: from Fred Ott's Sneeze to the 2017 Oscars, this category covers noted films, actors/actresses, scenes, etc.

Music: If it was sung or played, it'll be here. This covers music from the last 60-70 years.

TV: From the Dumont Network to reality TV, this category covers all things television.

Other Entertainment / Misc: Anything that isn't TV/Movies/Music or any of the other categories. It could include tourist sites, memes, websites, etc.

Gaming & Toys: Video games, board games, toys and any other forms of enjoyment.

Food & Drink: If you've eaten it or drank it, it'll be here

Lit: From comic books to young adult literature to modern best-sellers
